“Café Luso”



Café Luso today occupies the old coach-houses and cellars of the S. Roque Palace, one of the buildings that withstood the 1755 earthquake. The original vaults, dating from the XVIIth century, are still there. The Café Luso is also a cultural space, where shows that combine fado and theatre have already been performed

and the place where famous singers like Amália Rodrigues and Tony de Matos started their careers.
