

226th ECS Meeting

The 226th ECS meeting took place in Atlanta, USA, from 13 to 17 of October 2019. Scientists, engineers and industry leaders came from Europe, Japan, Canada, USA, India, Korea, Singapore, Taiwan, Israel, Mexico and China to share the latest scientific and technical developments in solid state and electrochemistry science and technology. The meeting program included more than 50 symposia with 1924 oral and 563 poster communications. One of the sessions was dedicated to Plasma Nanoscience and Technology. The session was chaired by Uros Cvelbar and one of the invited talks was given by Eva Kovačević, where important results concerning PEGASUS project were presented that triggered interesting discussions.
